# **Sweepstakes**Lynn Zagarella

My thanks to the exhibitors who showed dogs to me at your Regional Specialty. It is always an honor to be allowed to put hands on and evaluate dogs who represent fellow breeders' breeding programs. My priorities when judging are type, type and type. I am looking for quite a rectangular dog as the proportions called for in our breed standard describe an outline much longer than tall, in a ration of 4 height to 5 length, This is longer in body than a GSD whose standard calls for proportions of 9 to 10. We have unfortunately failed to educate many judges whose eye is now accustomed to seeing square or just off square Beardies in their rings. We must continue working to change this by showing dogs with proper silhouettes. Movement is an important aspect of type. Our breed is one built for "endurance trotting" and as such needs to have efficient, effortless, effortless, ground-covering movement. Coming and going faults require extra energy to perform and so these also have to be considered. Thank you again for inviting me!

#### 9-12 mo dog

Cool Heart's Edition for McCrystal - Dark slate 11.5 month old male. Good size and lovely outline. Nice head piece. Easy, ground-covering sidegait. Well presented and trained and sympathetically handled. Time and maturity should help him body up and expand in ribcage which will improve his coming and going. Eye color too light for coat color at this time.

## 2023 Specialty Results and Critiques - (con't)

#### Best of Opposite Sex In Sweepstakes

#### 12-15 mo dog

Heartstone What's Not To Love - Medium-sized blue dog, 12.5 mo old. Moderate in every way. Giving his handler lots of trouble and I was unable to assess his movement. Please remember that this is an intelligent herding breed that needs some sort of incentive to play our dogshow game with us!

#### 6-9 mo bitch

Kelkary's Rambling Rose at Brandmar - Black, well-coated 7.5 mo old puppy bitch. Good boning, lovely type and outline I would like to see her a shade larger for her age. Easy movement, clean coming and going. Spoiled her picture by carrying her tail too high today.

#### 12-15 mo bitch

Heartstone The Mist Is In The Air - Blue 12.5 mo old female, littermate to the 12-15 mo old male. Like him, she is also moderate in every aspect of size and make. Feminine head and expression, good reach of neck and level topline standing and moving. Easy, effortless strides and clean coming and going. My notes say "wants to do by her own self!", as Beardies often do. She will benefit from being convinced that more teamwork with her handler can improve her already pretty picture.

#### **Best Puppy In Sweepstakes**

#### Veteran 7-10 Yrs Bitch

CH Sebring Get Off My Cloud CGC - Lovely type on this almost 9 year old blue female. She owns the ring with her presence and is in beautiful condition and coat. I would prefer a bit more length of body to fit my ideal. Well presented and handled she moved with smooth, ground- covering strides. She is not at all showing her age and is still in her prime.

Very promising young boy. Lovely beardie expression. His substance and correct proportions made his movement smooth and effortless.

She was very feminine. She had nice length of neck which blended into her shoulders. Nice length of back giving her a nice solid topline.

She had a lovely beardie expression. She was very pretty on the stack. Nice length of neck which blended into a good shoulder and good length of back. She was very balanced! On her down and back she was just a little wide in the front.

Very nice head with a great beardie expression. She was very nice to examine. She was very balanced both moving and standing. On this day her movement was easy and smooth which made her my WINNERS Bitch. To my surprise her daughter went RESERVE

Very nice length to height ratio. She had a pretty beardie expression with good eye color. She was very clean coming and going and moved smoothly around the ring.

She was in good condition. She is a nice mover on her down and back. I would of preferred her to be a little shorter in the loin.
